



## **Support KCWC w/ our new King Scooper's Neighborhood Reward Program!!! Possibly the world's easiest fundraiser!**

King Soopers/Kroger stores have partnered with KCWC to create a special shopping card that functions like a gift card. When you use this card at King Soopers or their partner stores, the KCWC earns cash rewards. This money, in turn, helps to fund our programs, events and summer party.

There is no cost to participate in this program. Simply load or reload the card with any amount you like from your credit card, cash, check, or debit card at the check-out counter and use it like a gift card to pay for groceries. You will continue to earn your credit card benefits (such as airline miles) and gas points.

Here's how you can participate:

1. Pick up your special KCWC shopping card at any monthly meeting for only \$5.00 – your card will already be loaded with \$5.00 on it. It works like a “cash gift card” but links to our KCWC account. Each time you shop our Club will receive a cash reward!
2. Load your card by cash, check, debit or credit card (get credit card benefits).
3. Shop and pay with this KCWC cash gift card.
4. Reload when needed - even when you travel.
5. That's it. KCWC receives \$250 (5%) for every \$5,000 tracked through the program.

### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

*Q. How much money can I put on my gift card?*

A. You may put up to \$500 on your gift card at a time.

*Q. What can I buy with my gift card and can I use my card at any stores besides King Soopers?*

A. You can use your gift card to purchase any groceries, prescriptions, gas and even coffee (at in-store Starbucks) plus, your card can also be used at any of the following stores: Kroger, King Soopers, Ralphs, Frys, Smith's Food, City Market, Load & Jug, QFC, Food 4 Less, Dillons, Owens, Fred Meyer Jewelers, Littman & Barclay Jewelers

*Q. Is there anything I cannot buy with my gift card?*

A. The only items that you cannot buy with your card are other gift cards, stamps, lottery tickets, Tickets West and Western Union.

*Q. Will my card expire?*

A. Your card will become inactive only if you have a \$0 balance and it has not been used for more than 90 days. If this occurs you would need to get a new card from KCWC.

*Q. How do I know what my gift card balance is?*

A. Your card's balance will be printed on every receipt and you can also always ask your cashier to check your balance.
